

3 – SUPPORT our PENSIONERS

When elected Alistair pledges to: Support measures to increase the money pensioners receive by linking pensions to average earnings. Work to abolish age discrimination and encourage employers to appreciate the skills and experiences of older people.

4 – RAISE a GREEN VOICE for GLASGOW

When elected Alistair pledges to: Introduce a Bill to establish Local Food Officers throughout Scotland who will develop local food initiatives to connect consumers to producers, promote health, reduce food poverty, and stimulate local economies. It will also require schools and hospitals to source a percentage of food locally.

5 – STAND UP for CIVIL LIBERTIES

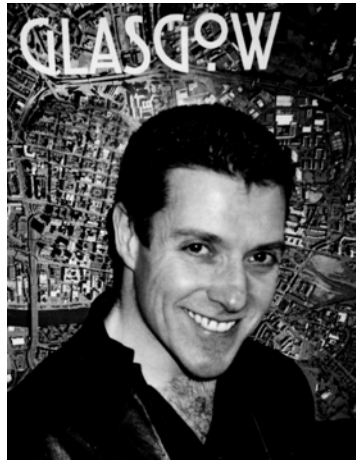
When elected Alistair pledges to: Organise an annual Civil Liberties Conference in the Parliament, to protect our democratic rights.

7 – CAMPAIGN for NO WAR with IRAN

When elected Alistair pledges to: Support our brave servicemen and women, whose purpose is the defence of our country, not fighting endless foreign wars for foreign interests. Use our public profile in the Scottish Parliament to campaign for **peace with Iran**, including **inviting Iranian leaders to Scotland** to dialogue with the Scottish people. He will be uniquely able to take such initiatives, which MSPs of other parties will be afraid of doing.
